\$3 MILLION DONATION FROM THE VERTEX FOUNDATION ESTABLISHES A NEW AMERICAN SOCIETY OF NEPHROLOGY INITIATIVE: EXCELLENCE IN KIDNEY CARE IMMUNOLOGY, TRAINING, AND EDUCATION

- The Vertex Foundation has committed to contributing \$3 million to the American Society of Nephrology (ASN) to establish Excellence in Kidney Care Immunology, Training, and Education (EKCITE).
- This program will train the kidney workforce in the implementation of the new immune-mediated therapies across a spectrum of kidney diseases.

**Washington**, **DC** (**November 12**, **2025**) — ASN is pleased to announce a new program: Excellence in Kidney Care Immunology, Training, and Education (EKCITE). EKCITE is established with a \$3 million donation from the Vertex Foundation and an additional \$2 million contribution from ASN. ASN is committed to endowing EKCITE by raising additional funding during the next year.

"New therapies have the potential to transform kidney care, but their implementation requires a health care workforce skilled in the delivery of such therapies, including immune monitoring, early identification and treatment of complications from infections and side effects, and management of adjunctive immunosuppressive therapy as needed," explained ASN President Prabir Roy-Chaudhury, MD, PhD, FASN, a transplant nephrologist.

While nephrologists—particularly transplant nephrologists—have traditionally received some training in these areas, a critical need exists for a cohort of nephrologists who are trained to care for immunosuppressed patients and those receiving innovative immune-mediated treatments. "These nephrologists would be at the forefront of the delivery and implementation of this new generation of immune-mediated therapies, both within nephrology and in collaboration with allied therapeutic areas," Dr. Roy-Chaudhury added.

"Renal medicine is experiencing a renaissance in drug development, and we're excited to be at the leading edge of this incredible wave of innovation," said Amit Sachdev, Chair of The Vertex Foundation. "The Vertex Foundation is proud to be the founding supporter of the EKCITE program to ignite new skills and capabilities within the nephrology community and ultimately ensure that people living with serious kidney diseases can benefit from innovations in care and transformative therapies on the horizon."
