Accreditation Statement

Claim CME/CNE/CPE

- 1. Log into the ASN eLearning Center: <u>asn-online.org/elearning</u>.
- 2. In the dashboard, select the activity "Kidney Week 2022 Annual Meeting."
- 3. In the activity, click the *Questionnaire* tab, and complete the *Demographics Questionnaire*.
- 4. Select the *Evaluation* tab.
 - a. Complete the General Evaluation.
 - b. Click the date sub-headers to expand and complete the session evaluations.
- 5. Select the *Claim Credit* tab. Use the *Credit Selection* dropdown to select your applicable credit type. If none apply, select *None of the Above Print Participation Certificate.*
 - a. If a CE credit type is selected:
 - The number of credits is defaulted to the maximum amount of 75. Adjust based on your actual participation.
 - Select the Claim button.
 - Select the *View Certificate* button. It may take up to 15 minutes for your certificate to show.
 - b. If None of the Above Print Participation Certificate is selected:
 - Select I understand the above continue to participation certificate.
 - Select Get Certificate.
