1. What are the dates of Kidney Week 2024?

- Wednesday, October 23 All <u>Early Programs</u> in San Diego.
- Thursday, October 24, through Sunday, October 27 ASN Annual Meeting in-person sessions, posters, exhibits, and more in San Diego.
- **Late November** All meeting content available in the ASN eLearning Center for in-person participants and Kidney Week On-Demand purchasers.

2. What is the time zone of Kidney Week 2024?

Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) in the United States.

3. What does Kidney Week 2024 include?

- Seven In-Person Early Programs (October 23): Acid-Base, Fluid, and Electrolyte Disorders; Advances in Research Conference "Genome Engineering and RNA-Based Therapeutics"; Critical Care Nephrology; Glomerular Diseases Update; Kidney Stone Prevention and Management; Onconephrology; and Point-of-Care Ultrasound (POCUS) in Nephrology. All Early Programs have in-person sessions only. There is no virtual programming. Each Early Program has a separate registration fee and offers continuing education credits. You may only register for one Early Program. You must participate in-person in San Diego for continuing education credits.
- **ASN Annual Meeting (October 24–27):** All sessions, posters, and exhibits will take place inperson in San Diego. All meeting content will be available in the ASN eLearning Center in late November.
- There is no virtual or hybrid event in 2024.

If accepted for poster presentation, an author must be available at the poster board at 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. PDT for presentation and discussion. Posters should also be uploaded as ePosters for viewing on-demand starting Thursday, October 24, at 10:00 a.m. PDT.

17. Will there be continuing education credits (CME/CNE/CPE) and maintenance of certification (MOC) points for Kidney Week 2024? If so, how many credits/points?

Annual Meeting participants and Kidney Week On-Demand learners can claim up to 75 continuing education (CE) credits, American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) MOC points, and American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) MOC points.
