1. What are the dates and location of Kidney Week 2026?

- **Wednesday, October 21** – All [Early Programs](#) in Denver.
- **Thursday, October 22, through Sunday, October 25** – ASN Annual Meeting in-person sessions, posters, exhibits, and more in Denver.
- **Mid-November** – All meeting content available in the ASN Learning Center for in-person participants and Kidney Week On-Demand purchasers.

Most Kidney Week activities will take place at the [Colorado Convention Center](#).

2. What is the time zone of Kidney Week 2026?

Mountain Daylight Time (MDT) in the United States.

3. What does Kidney Week 2026 include?

- **Seven In-Person Early Programs (October 21):** [Advances in Research Conference on Targeting Therapeutics](#); [ADPKD Clinical Updates](#); [Cardiovascular-KIDNEY-Metabolic Framework](#); [Critical Care Nephrology](#); [Glomerular Diseases Update](#); [Onconephrology](#); and [Point-of-Care Ultrasound \(POCUS\) in Nephrology](#). All Early Programs have in-person sessions only. There is no advance on-demand content. Each Early Program has a separate registration fee and offers continuing education credits (except the Advances in Research Conference). You may only register for one Early Program. You must participate in-person in Denver for continuing education credits.
- **ASN Annual Meeting (October 22–25):** All sessions, posters, and exhibits will take place in-person in Denver. All meeting content will be available in the ASN Learning Center in mid - November.
- There is no virtual or hybrid event in 2026.

The call for late-breaking abstracts opens on Wednesday, July 8, and closes on Wednesday, September 2, at 2:00 p.m. EDT.

11. How will posters be viewed, presented, etc.?

Posters will be presented in-person in Denver on Thursday, October 22, Friday, October 23, and Saturday, October 24, from 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. MDT (each day) in the exhibit hall. If accepted for poster presentation, an author must be available at the poster board at 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. MDT for presentation and discussion. Posters should also be uploaded as ePosters for viewing on-demand starting Thursday, October 22, at 10:00 a.m. MDT.

18. Will there be continuing education credits (CME/CNE/CPE) and maintenance of certification (MOC) points for Kidney Week 2026? If so, how many credits/points?

Annual Meeting participants and Kidney Week On-Demand learners can claim up to **65** continuing education (CE) credits, American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) MOC points, and American Board of Pediatrics (ABP) MOC points. Please note that select Annual Meeting sessions do not offer CE credits; these include (but are not limited to) plenaries and oral abstract sessions.

For Early Programs, CE credits vary from program to program, and MOC points are not offered. [Click here](#) for more information. Please note that the Advances in Research Conference does not offer CE credits.

Early Program participants can pick up *printed* Certificates of Attendance (not CE certificates for US participants) on Wednesday, October 21, at the programs. Annual Meeting participants can access *online* Certificates of Attendance (not CE certificates for US participants) starting October 22, 2026, through January 31, 2027.
